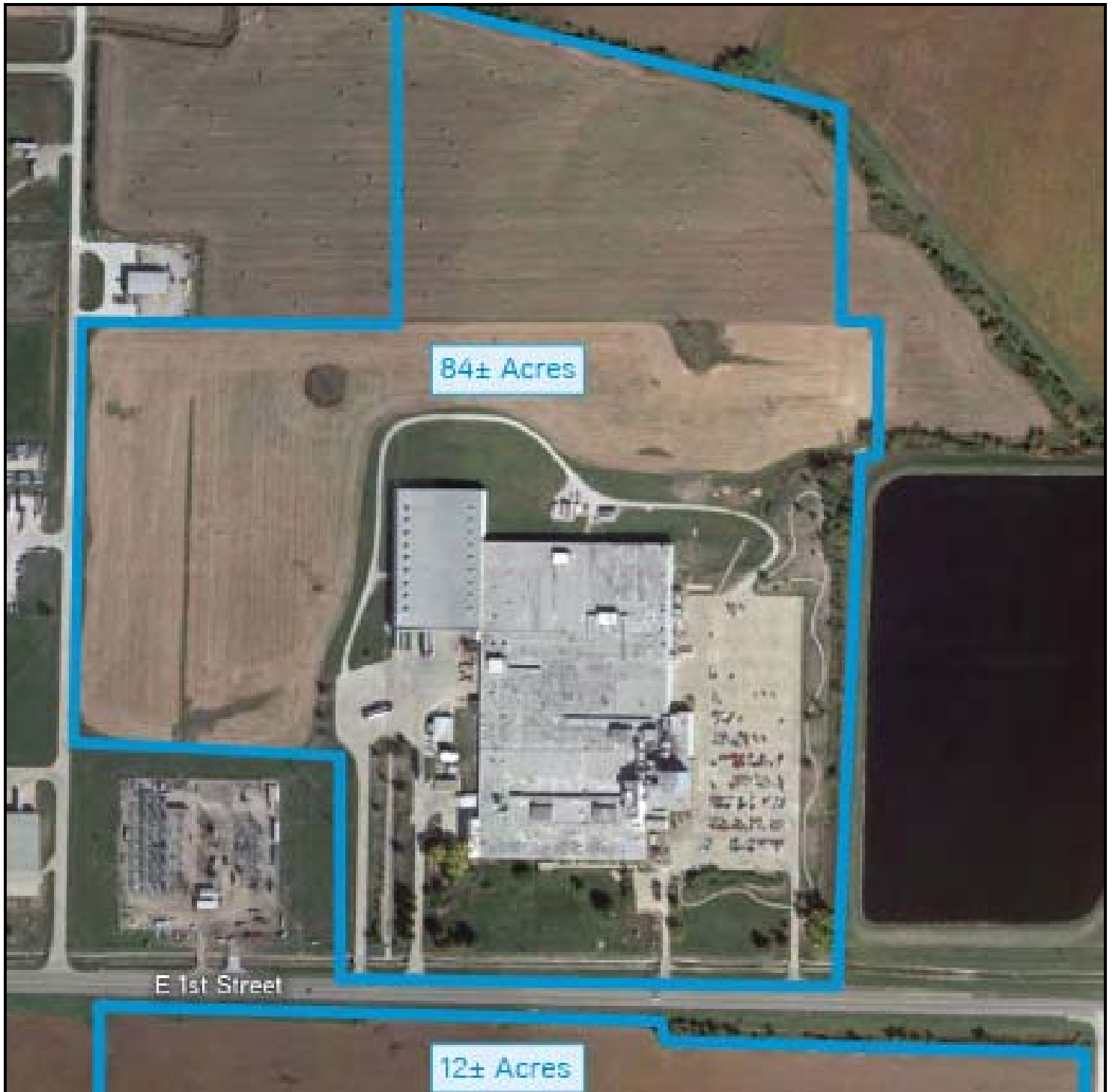
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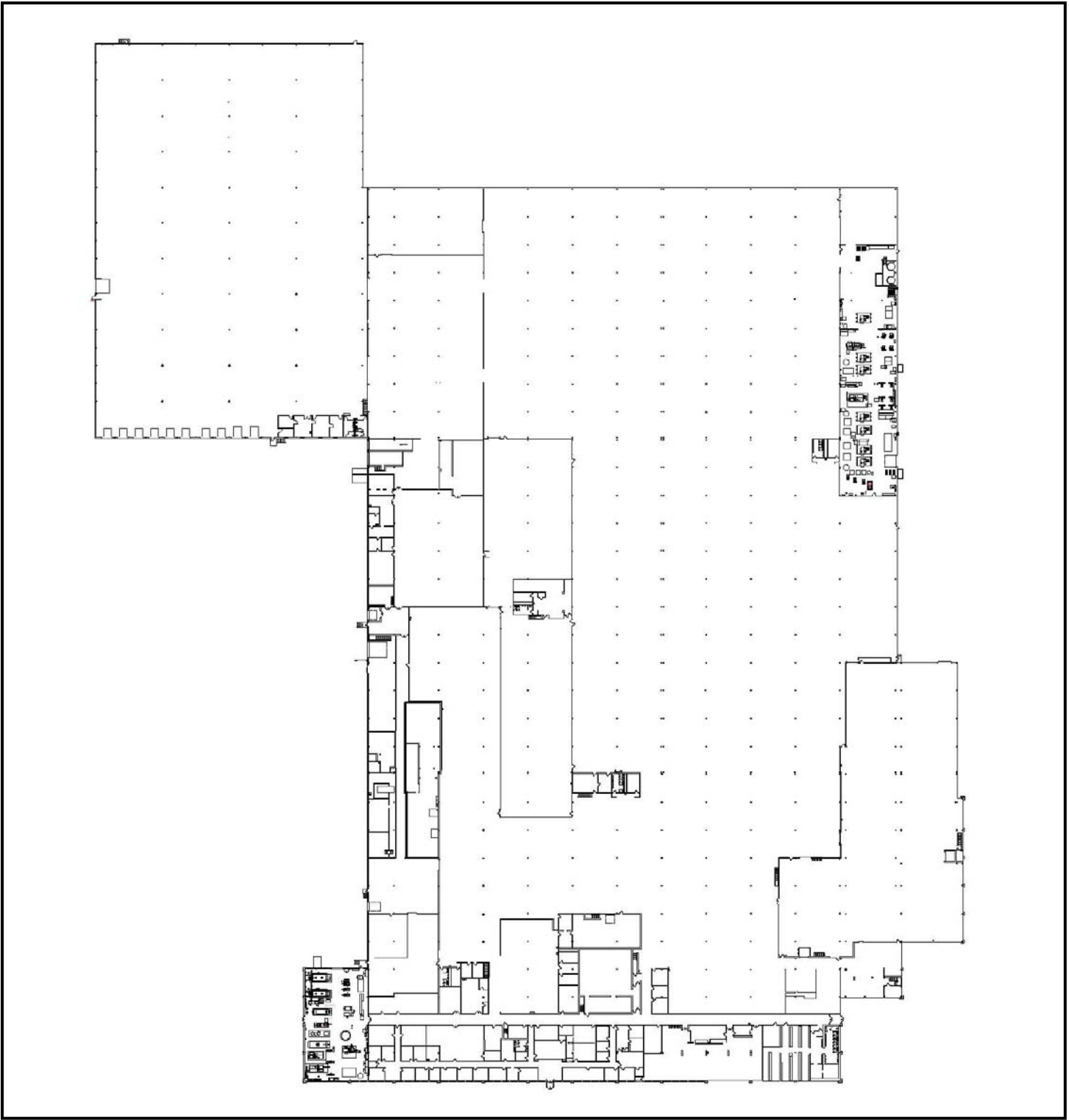

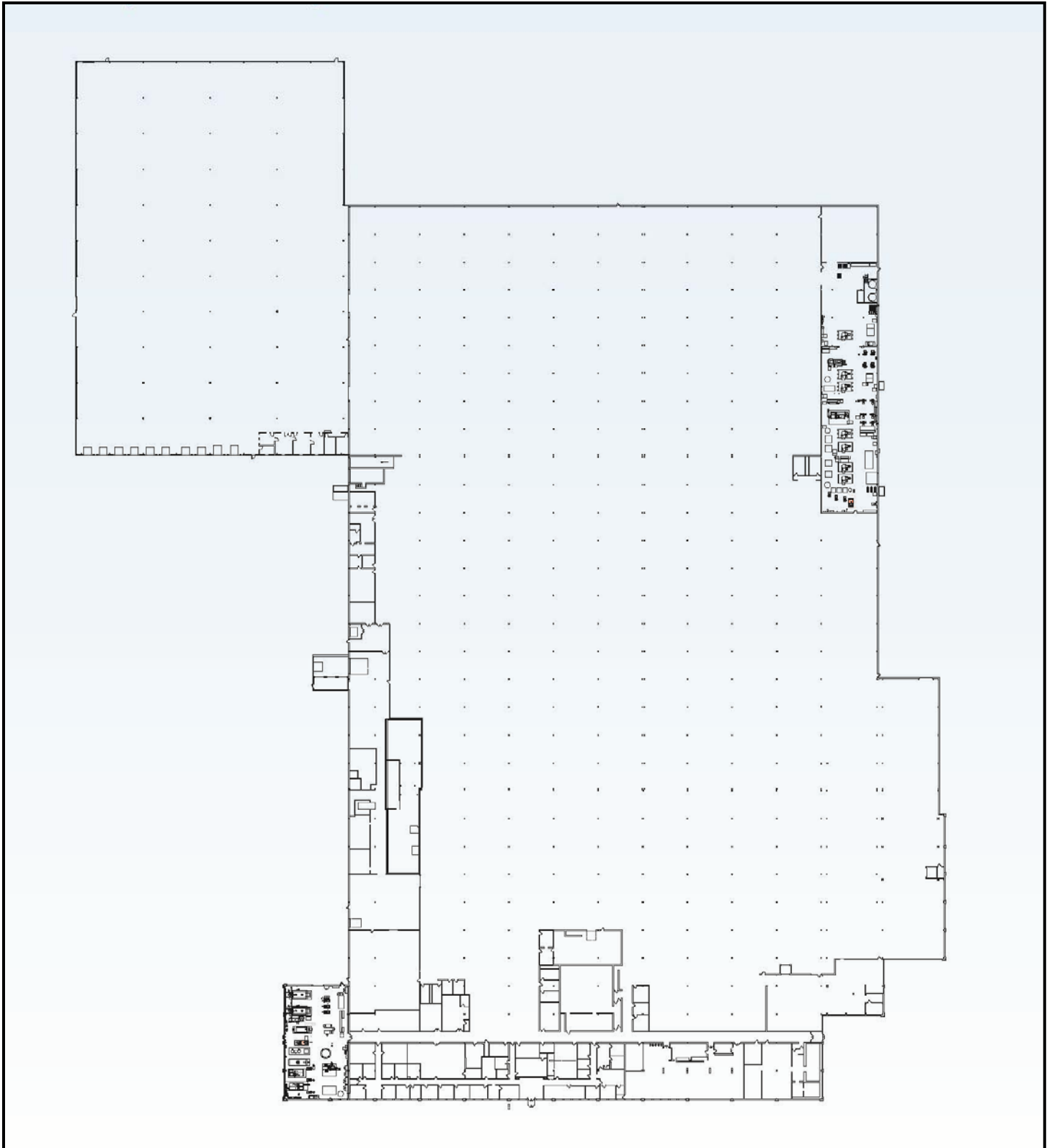
Aerial View

Currently, 46.4% of the 5,949 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 47.3%, renter occupied; and 6.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 5,758 housing units in the area - 47.7% owner occupied, 45.3% renter occupied, and 7.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.46%. Median home value in the area is \$131,026, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.18% annually to \$160,833.
